

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All the above classes are open to horses and ponies that have qualified by jumping a
- double clear at any of the qualifying venues.
- Horses and ponies who are currently registered must not have won more than £100.00 actual prize money since 1st January 2012. Weston Lawns have the right to consult British Showjumping regarding any competitors.
- All Competitors must be a minimum of a bronze member of Weston Lawns. (£10 runs Jan to Dec annually)
- Competitors must ensure that they warm-up in the correct collecting ring. Failure to adhere to this rule may result in elimination.
- Classes will be run under British Showjumping rules – except we will allow 3 refusals.
- Dress for the unaffiliated jumping will be competition wear.
- No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers or their property, servants or anyone in connection with the event.
- It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising thereto.
- The decision of the Judges is final.
- All class prize money and prizes in kind are awarded on a pro-rata basis (5:1) according to the number of entries received.
- Children (persons under age of 16) must not be left of the premises unattended.
- If you are competing at Weston Lawns and have travelled alone, you must notify the Secretary and leave contact details in case of an emergency.
- Stables must be left clean and tidy with banks up. Only stables booked may be used.
- Drawn orders will take place at 4pm the day prior to the competition, withdrawals after this time will be charged the full entry fee. Drawn orders will be posted on our web site by 5pm the day prior to the competition.
- If any person wishes to lodge a complaint, this must be done so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a deposit of £50 (which will be returned if the complaint is upheld).
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, amend the details of the schedule should it become necessary, or to cancel any class with insufficient entries.
- Dogs **MUST** be kept on a lead at all times and be cleaned up after
