

- ◆ All classes are open to both horses and ponies that have qualified by jumping and registering a double clear at any unaffiliated show jumping competition.
- ◆ Competitors must ensure that they warm up in the correct collecting ring. Failure to adhere to this rule may result in elimination.
- ◆ All Competitors must become a minimum of a bronze member of Weston Lawns, please present your membership card when entering.
- ◆ Classes will be run under BSJA rules – except we will allow 3 refusals.
- ◆ Dress for the unaffiliated jumping will be competition wear.
- ◆ No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers or their property, servants or anyone in connection with the event. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising thereto.
- ◆ The decision of the Judges is final.
- ◆ If any person wishes to lodge a complaint, this must be done so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a deposit of £50 (which will be returned if the complaint is upheld).
- ◆ The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, amend the details of the schedule should it become necessary, or to cancel any class with insufficient entries.
- ◆ Horses and ponies who are currently registered British Showjumping must not have won more than £100.00 actual prize money since January 2010. Weston Lawns have the right to consult the British Showjumping regarding any competitors.
- ◆ Classes 1, 2 & 3 are only open to pony and rider combinations who are not currently registered with British Showjumping.
- ◆ Dog s **MUST** be kept on a lead at all times and be cleaned up after – Failure to comply will result in dogs being banned.
- ◆ Prize money will not be paid until payment has been received for entry and will be forfeited if not collected at the end of the competition.
- ◆ Children (persons under age of 16) must not be left of the premises unattended.
- ◆ If you are competing at Weston Lawns and have travelled alone, you must notify the Secretary and leave contact details in case of an emergency.
- ◆ Stables must be left clean and tidy with banks up. Only stables booked may be used.
- ◆ Drawn orders will take place at 5pm the day prior to the competition, withdrawals after this time will be charged the full entry fee. Drawn orders will be posted on our web site by 5pm the day prior to the competition.
